

Tour Conditions – The Israel Experience

Tour Price and Upgrades

The total cost of the tour is \$6,100 per person based on double occupancy. For those requesting single occupancy, an additional charge of \$1,500 will apply. Upgrade options include Premium Economy for \$3,700 or Business Class for \$8,500, both of which are subject to availability. Prices are valid until ninety days before departure or while supplies last. All pricing assumes payment by check or money order. Payments made by credit card will incur a \$175 processing fee—\$25 applied to the deposit and \$150 to the trip balance.

Passport and Travel Documentation

Each traveler must possess a valid passport that remains valid for at least six months beyond the tour dates. U.S. citizens do not require a visa to enter Israel, however all participants must acquire and Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA). Participants are responsible for securing their own passport and ETA and submitting a clear copy of both to Blue Diamond Travel prior to departure.

Air Transportation

Round-trip airfare in economy class will depart from either JFK or EWR. These fares are non-refundable and are subject to change. Any increase in airline taxes or fuel surcharges that may occur prior to departure will be passed on to the participant by Blue Diamond Travel.

Land Transportation

All ground transportation and airport transfers throughout the tour will be provided via deluxe motor coach, ensuring comfort and convenience during all scheduled activities and travel segments.

Accommodations

Lodging throughout the tour will be in five-star hotels. Accommodations are based on double occupancy, with rooms featuring private bathrooms. Single rooms are available upon request for an additional charge and are subject to availability. In cases where a participant cannot provide a roommate and Blue Diamond Travel is unable to match one, the participant will be required to pay the single supplement, which may be invoiced after the final payment deadline.

Meals

Three meals per day will be provided during the tour. Most meals will be kosher and designed to meet a variety of dietary needs. Participants with specific dietary restrictions should notify Blue Diamond Travel in advance, and every effort will be made to accommodate those requirements.

Insurance

Blue Diamond Travel and the Tour Hosts act solely as intermediaries for suppliers and are not liable for loss, damage, theft, or personal injury. To mitigate potential travel risks, all participants are strongly advised to purchase trip cancellation, travel delay, and medical insurance. Terms of Change

All tour conditions are subject to regulatory changes governed by ARC, IATA, and airlines. Prices are quoted in U.S. dollars and are subject to adjustment. Every effort will be made to maintain pricing stability, but changes may occur due to circumstances beyond our control.

Responsibilities and Liability

By registering, participants agree that neither Blue Diamond Travel LLC nor the Tour Hosts, including their agents and affiliates, are responsible for personal injury, property loss, or changes in itinerary due to delays, strikes, breakdowns, customs issues, or other disruptions. Securing appropriate travel documentation remains the sole responsibility of each participant.

Registration and Deposit

A deposit of \$500 per person is required within ten business days of registration, of which \$300 is non-refundable. Registrations made within thirty days of departure must be accompanied by full payment.

Payment Deadlines

Fifty percent of the total cost is due by March 13, 2026, and the full balance must be paid by May 13, 2026. Accepted forms of payment include check, money order/cashier's check and credit card. Credit card payments are subject to a \$175 processing fee. Reservations not paid in full by the final deadline are subject to cancellation, with no liability on the part of Blue Diamond Travel or the Tour Host.

Cancellations and Refunds

Cancellations will incur a minimum fee of \$300 to cover administrative costs. Cancellations made 75 to 90 days prior to departure will result in forfeiture of the entire \$500 deposit. Cancellations made between 60 and 74 days prior to departure will be charged 50 percent of the full tour cost, plus any airline fees. No refunds will be provided for cancellations made within 59 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellations must be submitted in writing and mailed via Certified Mail to Blue Diamond Travel, P.O. Box 242058, Little Rock, AR 72223. In the event of war, natural disaster, or other unavoidable events, refunds will be limited to funds successfully recovered from third-party vendors. Travel insurance is strongly recommended.

Physical Requirements

Participants should be physically capable of walking moderate distances on uneven terrain, climbing stairs, and boarding and exiting buses without assistance. Anyone unable to meet these requirements must travel with a personal assistant.

Photography and Media Use

Photographs and video footage will be taken throughout the tour. These may be used in participant photo albums, highlight DVDs, promotional materials, and social media. Participants who prefer not to be photographed must notify Blue Diamond Travel in writing.

Inclusions

The tour price includes round-trip airfare from EWR or JFK, three meals daily (excluding soft drinks and alcoholic beverages), entrance fees to all sites, all applicable taxes and tips, hotel and airport transfers, deluxe motor coach transportation, professional English-speaking guides, five-star hotel accommodations (where available), robe rental at the Jordan River, towel rental at the Dead Sea, a photo book, a link with downloadable tour images, a highlight DVD, and various additional amenities.
