

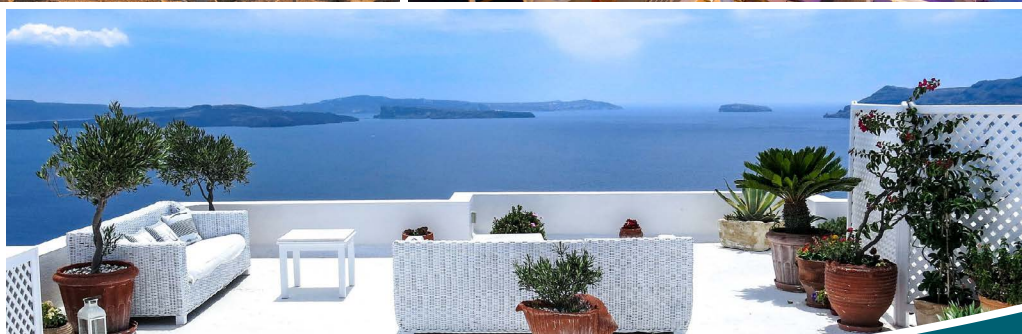
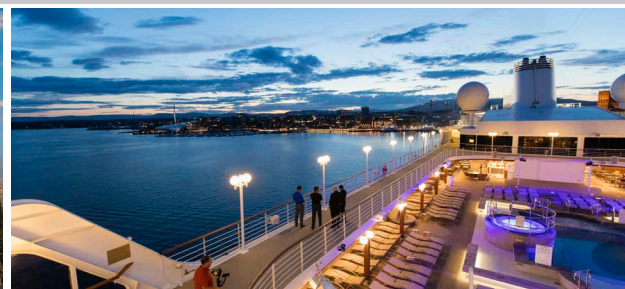

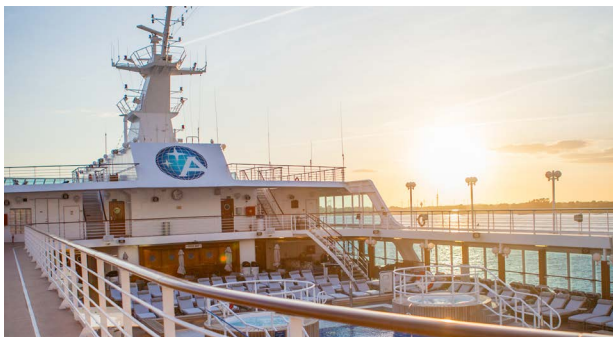




Message from GOVERNOR MIKE HUCKABEE

ITINERARY



Saturday, October 28th - Depart the USA

Sunday, October 29th - Athens, Greece

Arrive in Athens and see the best of Athens on a panoramic drive designed for those who prefer a more leisurely tour of the city. Board a comfortable coach for a narrated tour covering both modern and ancient attractions, including the Academy, Hadrian's Arch, the Temple of Olympian Zeus, the National Gardens, and a stop at the pedestrian zone below the majestic Acropolis. Conclude with free time to shop in the picturesque Plaka, the city's most ancient neighborhood. Transfer to your hotel for dinner and overnight (Late arrivals may experience a shorter panoramic tour and reduced free time).

Monday, October 30th - Athens, Greece

Travel to the legendary city of Athens for an awe-inspiring immersion into Greek history, mythology, and might. Upon arrival, you'll begin a narrated sightseeing drive that winds past the ruins of the Temple of Olympian Zeus and the Panathenaic Stadium, an ancient wonder reborn as the site of the first modern Olympics in 1896. Your drive will lead to the most iconic ancient site in Greece – the Acropolis. Climb the steep steps leading to this complex of temples and buildings dating back to the 5th century BC and built as a grand monument to thought and the arts. Witness the Temple of Athena Nike and explore the iconic Parthenon, dedicated to the Goddess Athena and offering sweeping panoramas overlooking the city below. A short walk from the ruins leads to Mars Hill, where Paul preached to the Athenians (Lunch onboard the ship upon arrival).

Tuesday, October 31st - Santorini, Greece - Day is on your own. *Guests may purchase excursions from Azamara*

Dock in Santorini today, one of the most beautiful of the Greek islands, where picturesque whitewashed villages topped with brilliant blue domes stand in stark contrast to the sheer drop cliffs overlooking the Aegean Sea. The island itself perches on the edges of a volcano whose eruption 3,500 years ago is thought to have led to the collapse of the Minoan civilization. You may choose to stay on the ship and enjoy the many amenities offered, or you may choose to wander this charming island on your own today. (B,L,D)

Villages and Vintages of Santorini - 4 hrs 15 mins - SO14 - Price is TBA

Savor the tantalizing flavors, subtle charms, and exquisite vistas of Santorini on this excursion across the island's rugged volcanic landscape. Your coach will climb some 800 feet to the top of the caldera, where you'll view the still active volcanic islet in the bay below. Stop in the village of Oia, perched high atop a craggy cliff at the northernmost point of Santorini. Wander about narrow cobblestone avenues lined with the beaming white stone of classic Cycladic architecture. From charming shops to splendid domed churches to a surprising collection of art galleries, a walk through Oia delights at every turn. Continue to a local winery to learn how Santorini wine is produced and sample some favorite vintages perfectly paired with homemade Greek mezes. Your tour ends in Fira, where you can independently explore the pedestrian paths that weave through Santorini's historic capital or return to the port via cable car. Activity Level: Medium

Akrotiri: The Lost City Excavations - 3 hrs 45 mins - SO39 - Price is TBA

Delve deep into the history of Santorini at one of the island's most mind-boggling discoveries — a Bronze Age city lost in 1450 BC to an epic volcanic eruption. Legend has it that the volcanic eruption that buried this town under 160 feet of pumice is the very same that vanquished the fabled city of Atlantis. Who knows for sure? What is certain, however, is that in 1930 the site was discovered, and 37 years later, the completed excavations revealed the remains of a once glorious city of more than 30,000 inhabitants. Walk the same cobbled paths they took. See their ancient homes and shops. Uncover the mysteries of life ages ago. Continue this history-making tour at the village of Akrotiri with a narrated exploration of five fortified medieval settlements. Finally, return to lively Fira for a little self-guided sightseeing and shopping. Activity Level: Medium

Panoramic Santorini - 3 hrs 30 mins - SO4L - Price is TBA

You'll be met by your guide at the pier and drive to the Mountain of Prophet Elijah, the island's highest point. The next stop will be at the Caldera cliff top view point for spectacular views of the deep blue sea surrounding the island that make up the volcanic

caldera of Santorini. Enjoy a light refreshment before driving south across the island to Kamari, passing picturesque villages and dramatic views along your way, briefly stopping at the Agios Nektarios Church before enjoying some leisure time at the black-sand beach Kamari is now famous for. You'll then be escorted back to Athinios port, where a tender will take you back to the ship. Activity Level: Mild

Sailing the Caldera of Santorini - 3 hrs - SO3L - Price is TBA

Set sail on a captivating voyage that glides across the turquoise Aegean to showcase the monumental landscape of the Caldera of Santorini. You'll board a traditional Greek vessel known as a Kaiki and set a course for the isle of Nea Kameni. Be sure to have your camera ready as you approach the still active volcanic island. Gaze up at the ash cliffs that rise from the azure waters and learn about the monumental volcanic eruption that forever changed this landscape some 3,500 years ago. You'll journey to the nearby isle of Thirassia, home to only 350 inhabitants, and sail past the red Caldera walls that tower above picturesque Ammoudi Beach. Snap photos of the village of Oia and panoramic vistas as you venture into Armeni Bay. As you take in the scenery, your attentive crew will serve up fresh Greek mezes and local wines to complete this unforgettable experience.

Activity Level: Mild

Wednesday, November 1st - Kusadasi, Turkiye

Marvel at the ancient city of Ephesus, known as an open-air archaeological museum. Delve into the incredible treasures of Ephesus, including an in-depth exploration of the Terrace Houses. First built in the 10th century B.C. and lasting until its abandonment under Ottoman rule, Ephesus dazzles visitors with its ruins. See the Odeon, a concert hall, the steam baths of Scholastica, the famed two-story Library of Celsus, and the Grand Theater where St. Paul preached. Walk the Arcadian Way, a procession route of Cleopatra and Marc Anthony. Activity Level Moderate to strenuous (Option will be given by guide upon arrival). (Lunch onboard the ship prior to afternoon excursion).

Thursday, November 2nd - Day at Sea

Enjoy one of the many onboard activities and/or group gatherings as you rest and relax aboard the Azamara Onward. Take the opportunity for a salon visit or a massage at the spa. The day is yours to do as you please!

Friday, November 3rd, Valetta, Malta

Embark on a narrated tour of Valetta, the capital of Malta, and a city replete with medieval charm and extravagantly grand architecture. No exploration would be complete without a visit to Valetta's crowning jewel, St. John's Co-Cathedral. This baroque masterpiece was commissioned in 1572 by Grand Master Jean de la Cassiere for the Knights of St John. In fact, several Knights donated gifts of art to ensure it was adorned with only the finest works. Continue to Casa Rocca Piccola, a historic home offering a unique glimpse into the lives of Maltese nobility over the past 400 years. Enjoy a little free time to explore the area before heading to the imposing Mediterranean Conference Center. Set overlooking the Grand Harbour, it was originally built as a hospital for the Order of St. John of Jerusalem and was considered one of the finest in Europe during the 1600s. Activity Level: Strenuous

Saturday, November 4th - Catania, Sicily, Italy

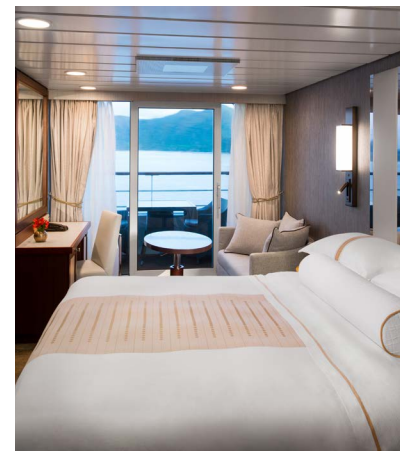
Between the Mediterranean Sea and Mount Etna lies the beautiful city of Catania, where it's "if it ain't Baroque don't fix it" architecture has earned it UNESCO World Heritage status. Choose from one of several included shore excursions. A wine tasting option will immerse you in Sicily's vineyards. Discover Syracuse's plethora of Greek, Roman, and Middle Ages architecture including Piazza Armerina & Villa Romana del Casale. If a more adventurous trek is your preference, ascend Mt. Etna for a closer look at this active volcano. Or enjoy Mt. Etna from

a distance in Taormina where its ancient Roman Theatre will provide dramatic views and shopping streets will furnish ample souvenirs and local crafts. Activity level will vary.

Sunday, November 5th & Monday, November 6th - Salerno, Italy

Discover the diverse beauty and heritage of the western coast of Italy as Azamara Onward spends two full days docked at Salerno. Choose from several included options that will immerse you in the infamous and remarkable ruins of Pompeii or Herculaneum that were covered in ash by Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD. Enjoy the wonderful culture and food found in Naples or Salerno at the Arechi Castle. Find Italy's natural history when you take in its gorgeous Amalfi Coast. Activity level will vary.

October 24 – DEPART THE USA

Your journey begins as you depart the USA on your international overnight flight.

October 25 – ARRIVE IN DUBAI

After being picked up at the airport, you will be transported to your hotel for overnight. (D)

October 26 – TOUR OLD DUBAI

After breakfast, journey to the Al Fahidi Historical Neighborhood to explore Old Dubai. Part of the attraction of the district, which showcases the traditional way of life in Dubai from the mid 19th century until the 1970s, is simply wandering through its narrow lanes. Here, you'll discover creative art spaces, museums and cafés housed in traditional L-shaped homes made from gypsum, coral and limestone. Look up and you can't miss the buildings topped with distinctive wind towers. While exploring this neighborhood, you will visit the Textile Souk full of colorful fabrics and kitsch souvenirs. Next, visit the Saruq Al Hadid museum to see the archaeological treasures that have been discovered in and around Dubai. Embark on a water taxi ride at Bur Dubai Abra Station by Dubai Creek. This waterway continues to reflect Dubai's historic roots back when early settlers relied on its waters for their livelihood. You will queue for a short trip across the creek to Deira on traditional wooden boats known as abras. Once on the other side visit the Gold Souk, where you can haggle with shopkeepers for beautiful jewelry before continuing to the Spice Souk. As you wander through the stalls, you can savor the aromas of cardamom, turmeric, dried lemons and rose petals. After touring, check into your hotel and enjoy dinner and rest. (B, L, D)

October 27 – ABU DHABI & DINNER CRUISE

Embark on this exhilarating tour to the highlight destinations of Abu Dhabi. As you travel to your first destination along the Gulf coast of Abu Dhabi, listen to the region's rich history and culture. Let's visit the architectural beauty of the country's largest mosque, Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque, which is known as the acclaimed symbol of contemporary Islam. The place offers a feast to eyes as it blends the cultural diversity of Islamic art and contemporary design. You will be driven to the next destination, Abu Dhabi Corniche. Feel relaxed seeing the sweeping curve of clean water harbor, pearl white sand beaches and the beautiful promenade that stretches the Northwest city shore. Next, stop at Emirates Palace, a highly celebrated destination in the UAE. Get a chance to pose in front of this eminent destination and take a lot of photos. Later on, travel to the next photo stop destination, the stunning five towers of Abu Dhabi, Etihad Towers. The towers shout out the aggregate story of everything Abu Dhabi is and the futuristic view of the Emirate. Being the combination of luxury and modern views, the place is an ideal destination during the Abu Dhabi visit. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Now that your appetite is full, you will be taken to the next destination, Qasr Al Watan. The palace is the reflection of Emiratis and

their leaders. Absorb the essence of culture, architectural features and the awe-inspiring history of Emirates. Learn about the amazing journey of the spurring Arabian design to the present state. Return to Dubai and freshen up at your hotel before embarking on your dinner cruise on the Bateaux Dubai. As you sail around Dubai, you will pass the illuminated Maktoum Bridge, Clock Tower, Twin Towers and Grand Mosque. (B, L, D)

October 28 – NEW DUBAI TOUR & DESERT TRIP

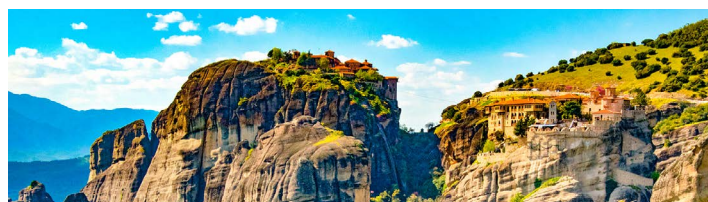
You begin your tour by driving to the famous man-made island, Palm Jumeirah. Cross the 800-meter-long underwater tunnel and reach the 12-kilometer-long water-breaker at the luxury resort Atlantis, The Palm. Make a photo stop and take some special souvenir pictures of the magnificent Atlantis hotel. You then continue on to the Dubai Marina, an exclusive residence, leisure, and trade area. Enjoy a short stroll along the water and admire the new skyline with over 260 skyscrapers from the Marina's yacht harbor. As a magnificent finale to your tour, you visit the Burj Khalifa, which at 828 meters is currently the tallest building in the world and located next to the Dubai Mall, one of the world's largest shopping centers with 1,200 shops. Visit the viewing platform at 452 meters above sea level. Ride the building's express elevator to the 124th floor at a speed of 10 meters per second. From there, you can enjoy a breathtaking 360-degree view of all of Dubai and its unique skyline. This afternoon, zoom into the remote Lahbab desert that lies outside the city. During the drive, your guide answers any questions and shares information about the region. Head off road into bright red dunes and have your camera ready to capture what looks like giant beanbags of sand. During a break to gather the convoy, make use of optional quad bikes on site. Then, hold tight as you cruise toward the highest slopes. Feel the adrenaline race as your vehicle plows up the dunes before sliding and slipping back down the slopes, churning up billowing clouds of sand in the process. Reach a high desert dune for a photo stop and admire 360-degree views of the desert landscape as the sun slowly sets. Take a camel ride and surf the dunes on a sandboard before you return to your hotel (Guests not wanting to visit the desert can be dropped off at the Dubai Mall for shopping and can stay to see the fountain show before returning on their own to the hotel). (B, L, D)

October 29 – DUBAI to ATHENS

Fly across the Mediterranean to Athens this morning and enjoy the best of Athens on a panoramic drive designed for those who prefer a more leisurely tour of the city. Board a comfortable coach for a narrated tour covering modern and ancient attractions, including the Academy, Hadrian's Arch, the Temple of Olympian Zeus, the National Gardens, and a stop at the pedestrian zone below the majestic Acropolis. Conclude with free time to shop in the picturesque Plaka, the city's most ancient neighborhood. Transfer to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B)

October 25 & 26 – USA to GREECE

Your journey begins as you depart the USA on your international overnight flight. Arrive in Thessaloniki, Greece, where you will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

October 27 – THESSALONIKI and VERIA (BEREA)

Discover Thessaloniki, where Paul was accused of turning the world upside down (Acts 17: 3-6). Explore St. George's Basilica, believed to be built over the synagogue where Paul preached, and reflect on the two epistles written to the Thessalonian church. Stroll through the Archaeological Museum and the beautiful basilicas of St. Sophia and St. Demetrios, dedicated to a distinguished Roman proconsul martyred for his Christian faith. You can look out over the second-largest city in Greece from the Old City Ramparts. Follow the path of Paul when he fled for the safety of Veria (Berea), where some accepted the new faith (Act 17: 10-12). Continue on to Kalambaka for dinner and overnight.

October 28 – METEORA and DELPHI

As you visit the rock forest of Meteora, imagine the Apostle Paul walking that treacherous terrain. Gaze up at the breathtaking Byzantine monasteries perched on soaring, sheer-sided sandstone pillars. In the 13th century, monks built the original wooden shelters that later became these monasteries. After a monastery tour, travel to Delphi, the religious center of the ancient Greek world and marked by the conical stone called the omphalos or "navel". Walk the Sacra Via to the

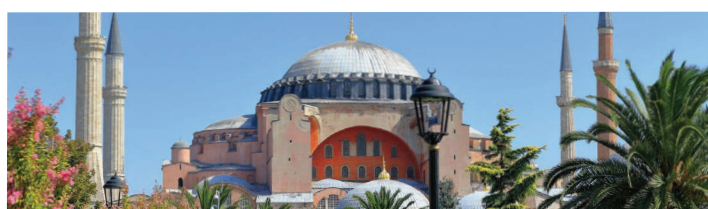
Athenian Treasury, theatre, and the Temple of Apollo, where the oracle performed her prophetic rituals. As you consider the pagan influence in Delphi alone, you will gain a new appreciation for the spiritual opposition the Apostle Paul faced. In the Museum are many ancient treasures, including the 5th-century, bronzed charioteer so detailed you can see his eyelashes. Continue to Athens for overnight.

October 29 – ATHENS

See the best of Athens on a panoramic drive designed for those who prefer a more leisurely tour of the city. Board a comfortable coach for a narrated tour covering modern and ancient attractions, including the Academy, Hadrian's Arch, the Temple of Olympian Zeus, the National Gardens, and a stop at the pedestrian zone below the majestic Acropolis. Conclude with free time to shop in the picturesque Plaka, the city's most ancient neighborhood. Transfer to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

October 30 – CORINTH & EMBARKATION

Wander the streets of ancient Corinth, home to the tent makers, Aquilla and Priscilla. Here, the Lord spoke to Paul in a vision, saying "I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city" (Acts 18:10). Many believed and were baptized (Acts 18:8). This was the beginning of the church at Corinth, to whom Paul would write two epistles. Stand on the Bema where Paul stood. Walk the marketplace and Temple of Apollo. Visit the Archaeological Museum then transfer to Pireaus to board the Azamara Onward.

October 23 & 24 - USA to ISTANBUL

Your journey begins as you depart the USA on your international flight. Upon arrival, meet your guide and transfer to your hotel in Istanbul.

October 25 - ISTANBUL

Enjoy a panoramic tour of Istanbul: Walls of Constantinople, the Golden Horn, Patriarchate and a Bosphorus cruise before continuing to the airport for your flight to Cappadocia. Arrive and overnight in Cappadocia at the hotel.

Start your walking tour of Rome from the hotel to see the Spanish Steps, the famous Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and the Navona Square. Stop for a pizza tasting during lunch. Continue your afternoon with a tour of the Coliseum featuring special access to the Arena Floor. Enjoy dinner on your own. (B, L)

November 12 - Vatican City & Christian Rome

Visit the Vatican, and explore its museum. Marvel at the beauty of St. Peter's Basilica, and stand in awe of Michaelangelo's frescoes in the Sistine Chapel. This evening, you will check into your deluxe hotel in Rome. Discover Rome on your own during the afternoon and evening as you dine on your own. (B, L)
